Hoe te reserveren? / How to reserve ?

1. Betaal zo snel mogelijk het totaal bedrag en je Zomer school is volledig betaald.

Whenever you pass the examinations you will receive your Black belt, certificate and Black belt card, via your Country Representative, from the Tokyo Honbu in about 6 weeks.

Also Special International Summer School Karate certificates will be awarded for passing the examinations.

During this Summer school there will be also training with the long Bo (about 180 cm). Whenever you like to use your own Bo bring him with you, if not then we will supply you with a new Bo for € 5,-.



Referee & Judge Course

This year there will be also a Referee & Judge course, if possible conducted by Japanese IKO Honbu Instructors.

- IKO certification is required to be considered as an IKO Judge or Referee at all IKO sanctioned Championship Events, such as the 9th World Open Tournament this year in Tokyo -.

This course will be given during the West European Summer School.

Shihan Gorai will send the details for this course and application forms very soon to the Secretary of the European Organization to publish it on the EKKO Web site.

When you want to follow the course (about 2 nights / 3 days), then it's necessary to make your room reservation as soon as possible. The price for 2 nights and three days accommodation and full board at the National Sport centre Pependal is € 195,-.

When you want to join us for the complete West European Summer School, Monday to Friday, follow the instructions in this brochure and you will have a wonderful Kyokushin experience.

Remember: late reservation can result in lack of accommodation!
